Rabbi Michael Chernick, PhD, is Deutsch Professor of Jewish Jurisprudence and Social Justice at HUC-JIR/New York. He was educated at Yeshiva College and Bernard Revel Graduate School and was ordained at Yeshiva University's Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary.

Dr. Tova Ganzel is Professor of Bible Studies at Bar-Ilan University and Michlelet Herzog. She received her MA and Ph.D. in Bible Study at Bar-Ilan and was the first woman certified by Nishmat as a Yoetzet Halacha - a halachik counselor in the laws of marital purity and ritual immersion.

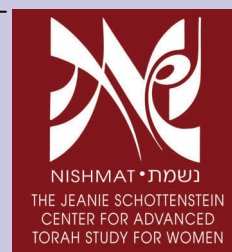
